Proposed Policy Revisions

Associate Superintendent Terry Downey presented the first reading of revisions to the following policies:

- New Policy JI *Student Rights and Responsibilities* – this policy reflects statutes related to student rights
- Revisions to Policies IJOA *Field Trips* and EEB *Business and Personnel Transportation Services*; and deletion of EEAG-R *Student Transportation in Private Vehicles* – changes to these policies reflect the recommendation by district administrators to eliminate the transportation of students in private vehicles.
