**Report and Demonstration Highlighting K-12
Technology Implementation Part II**

Assistant Superintendent for 21st Century Learning Mary Jo Conery introduced Curriculum Technology Integrators (CTIs) Cindy Jacobson (Esperero Canyon), Sarah Phillips (High School), and Lynn Wojcik (Orange Grove). Each CTI shared information regarding their roles and professional development activities related to technology on each of their campuses. Governing Board members and the audience participated in an interactive demonstration of the use of a “clicker” (response system) used by students in CFSD classrooms.
