

A Summary Report of the March 30, 2021 CFSD Governing Board Meeting



Update Regarding In-Person and Remote Learning

Superintendent Kamerzell provided an update on in-person learning in CFSD schools. All schools have followed a 5-day per week in-person learning schedule since March 15. In compliance with Governor Ducey's Executive Order 2021-04, all public elementary schools were to be open for in-person learning to any family requesting it. At middle and high schools, however, they were permitted to 'reduce attendance' for in-person learning because Pima County was in the COVID-19 Substantial Transmission category. When we moved to the Moderate or Low Transmission category, then grades 6-12 schools would need to admit all students who requested in-person learning, again per the Executive Order.

Pima County moved to the Moderate Transmission category at the end of last week, according to the Arizona Department of Health Services. On Tuesday, March 30, the district notified all K-12 families about this change, including elementary parents in case the lower transmission level would affect their decision-making about a learning option. Dr. Kamerzell added that she didn't anticipate a significant amount of additional movement to in-person learning anywhere in the district because CFSD schools had been admitting almost all of the families who requested in-person learning to-date.

Dr. Kamerzell provided the following update on the percentage of in-person learners at each school: Canyon View - 85%, Manzanita - 79%, Sunrise Drive - 81%, Ventana Vista - 76%, Esperero - 68%, Orange Grove - 67%, and Catalina Foothills High School = 46%

2021 Arizona Legislative / Governmental Activity

Board members discussed the efforts in the State to diminish or overturn Prop 208's income tax for support of K-12 public schools.
