STANDARDS FOR MUSIC ENSEMBLE MIDDLE SCHOOL ORCHESTRA – NOVICE (GRADE 6)

Concertino Strings is for beginning strings players and those who have played two or more years prior to grade 6.

CREATING (Imagine – Plan and Make)

Conceiving and developing new artistic ideas and work

MU.Cr1.1.MS.6 Compose and improvise melodic and rhythmic ideas or motives that reflect characteristic(s) of music or text(s) studied in rehearsal.

MU.Cr2.1.MS.6 Select and develop draft melodic and rhythmic ideas or motives that demonstrate understanding of characteristic(s) of music or text(s) studied in rehearsal.

MU.Cr2.2.MS.6 Preserve draft compositions and improvisations through standard notation and audio recording.

CREATING (Evaluate and Refine – Present)

Conceiving and developing new artistic ideas and work

MU.Cr3.1.MS.6 Evaluate and refine draft compositions and improvisations based on knowledge, skill, and teacher provided criteria.

MU.Cr3.2.MS.6 Share personally developed melodic and rhythmic ideas or motives - individually or as an ensemble - that demonstrate understanding of characteristics of music or texts studied in rehearsal.

PERFORMING (Select – Analyze – Interpret)
