#### Tennis

#### Math Club

Sunrise Drive's Math Team ranked 1st place in Sweepstakes at the state championship, and qualified five students for the national championship (only 20 Arizona students qualified). Their coach is Ning Hao.

## <u>Softball</u>

Two CFHS softball players have earned spots on international teams: Kyrie Denny - Under 18 German National Softball Team, Carys Lynch - under 22 and Under 18 Great Britain National Softball Team.

Four senior softball players were nominated to play in the Southern Arizona All-Star Senior Game: Vianae Ochoa, Carys Lynch, Emmelie Vargas, and Ellie Willis.

#### **Robotics**

CFHS Pioneer 327 Robotics Team won the THINK Award and the COMPASS Award, and took 3rd place for the INSPIRE Award, at the first Tech Challenge Arizona State Championship. They came in 5th place out of 38 teams. ## Speech and Debate

Josh Tint, Class of 2021, qualified to compete in the 2021 NSDA National Speech and Debate Tournament, which will be held online June 13-19. His coach is CFHS teacher Angela Hill.

### Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Our senior class had over 280 students - 60% of the senior class - complete the FAFSA prior to April 1 this year. It made CFHS the winner of the 2021 Arizona FAFSA Completion Contest in the large school category. CFHS was given Hewlett-Packard laptops to give away to three graduating members of the senior class. Two went to students who qualified for Pell Grants/Work Study through FAFSA, and one was awarded through a drawing among eligible seniors.

## National Merit Scholarship Program

New graduates Muhammad A. Dahshan '21, Claire G. Kross '21, and Maxon B. Rubin-Toles '21 are among the 12 Tucson seniors who received college-sponsored National Merit Scholarships. These Scholars were selected by a committee of college admissions officers and high school counselors, who appraised a substantial amount of information submitted by both the Finalists and their high schools: the academic record, including difficulty level of subjects, studied and grades earned; scores from the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®); contributions and leadership in school and community activities; an essay written by the Finalist; and a recommendation written by a high school official. Only 8,000 seniors nationwide are selected for this program.
