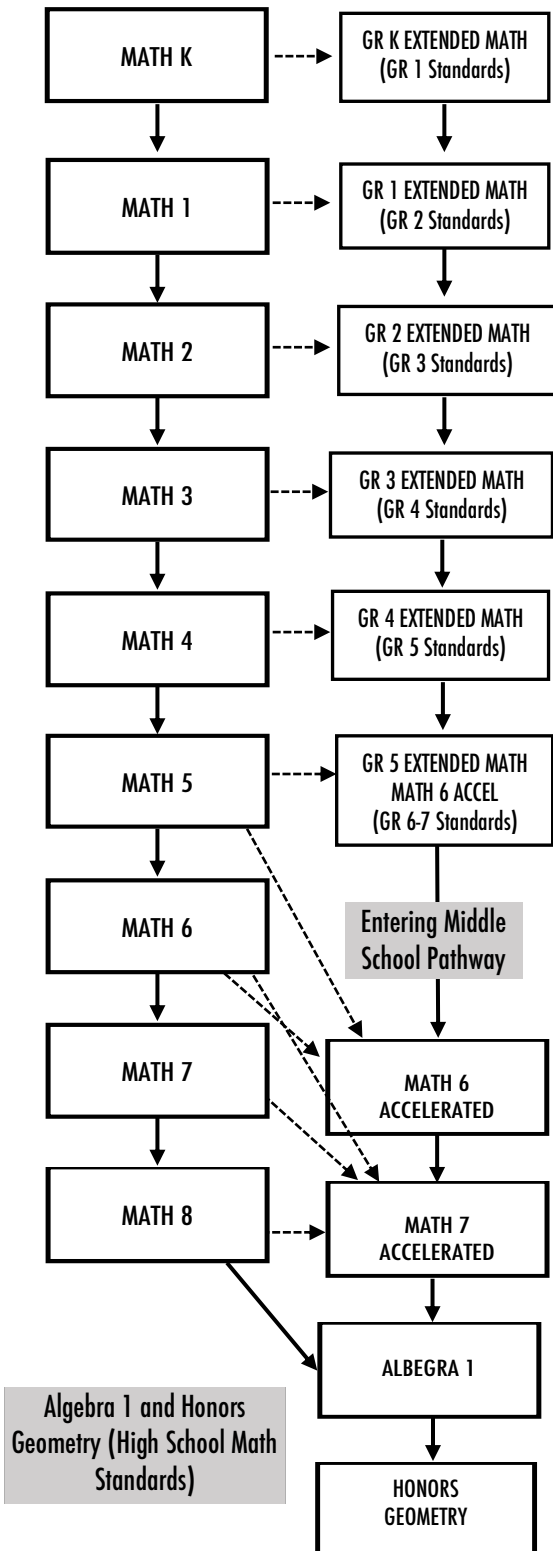

KINDERGARTEN – GRADE 8 PATHWAY

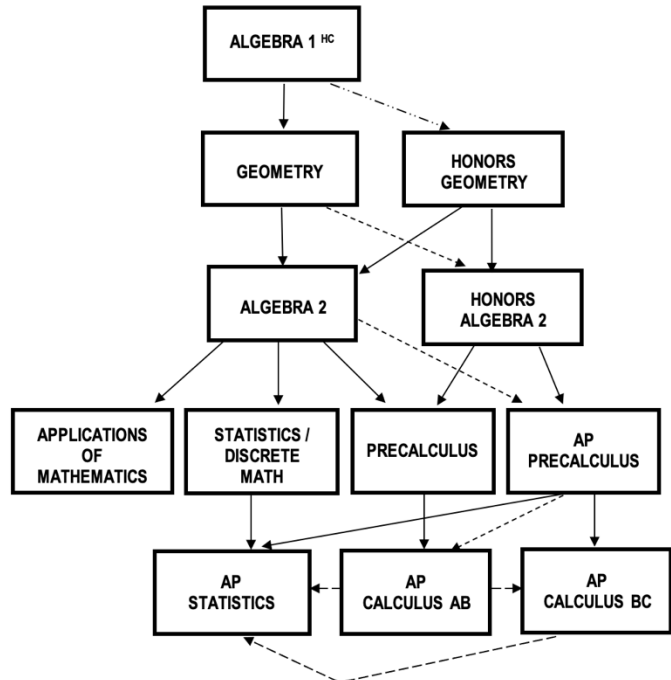


The elementary Extended Math program addresses the needs of K-5 students who consistently demonstrate the ability to think, learn, and perform at advanced levels in mathematics. Students who are placed in Extended Math demonstrate a readiness for math at least one year above grade level. They are identified for participation through a process that evaluates performance based on a set of criteria. Students may also be placed in out-of-level math courses that are two or more years beyond grade level if specific criteria are met and necessitate this placement.

Middle School students at grades 6-8 are identified for participation in accelerated or advanced (high school) mathematics courses based on a set of placement criteria.

Four credits of math are required for CFSD graduation: Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, and one additional course/credit beyond Algebra 2. Students seeking placement in Honors courses at the high school must meet specific criteria to ensure that students are prepared for the highest-level math courses.
