The Catalina Foothills School District (CFSD) is dedicated to providing our community with programs that increase independence and opportunities for students with low-incidence needs. Our Inclusion Programs offer a wide array of services designed to improve social/emotional, adaptive, communication, and functional academic skills in accordance with an individualized education plan.



Program Location

Students in the Inclusion Program attend class with their nondisabled peers, in their home schools, to the maximum extent possible.



Services & Therapy

CFSD offers transition support services, instruction on activities of daily living, targeted adult support, and functional academics. Students with severe impairments receive targeted adult support, occupational therapy, speech/language therapy, and physical therapy, as needed.



Graduation Tracks

Catalina Foothills High School offers two graduation tracks for students in the Inclusion Program:

- Regular High School Diploma: Students wishing to attain this diploma will demonstrate mastery of CFSD's academic standards using modifications to the content.
- Certificate of Achievement: Students wishing to attain this certificate will demonstrate a mastery of functional academics using an alternative curriculum.
