STANDARDS FOR MUSIC ENSEMBLE MIDDLE SCHOOL BAND – NOVICE

CREATING (Imagine – Plan and Make)

Conceiving and developing new artistic ideas and work

MU.Cr1.1.E.MS1 Compose and improvise melodic and rhythmic ideas or motives that reflect characteristic(s) of music or text(s) studied in rehearsal.

MU.Cr2.1.E.MS1 Select and develop draft melodic and rhythmic ideas or motives that demonstrate understanding of characteristic(s) of music or text(s) studied in rehearsal.

MU.Cr2.2.E.MS1 Preserve draft compositions and improvisations through standard notation and audio recording.

CREATING (Evaluate and Refine – Present)

Conceiving and developing new artistic ideas and work

MU.Cr3.1.E.MS1 Evaluate and refine draft compositions and improvisations based on knowledge, skill, and teacher-provided criteria.

MU.Cr3.2.E.MS1 Share personally developed melodic and rhythmic ideas or motives – individually or as an ensemble – that demonstrate understanding of characteristics of music or texts studied in rehearsal.

PERFORMING (Select – Analyze – Interpret)

Realizing artistic ideas and work through interpretation and presentation

MU.Pr1.1.E.MS1 Select varied repertoire to study based on interest (often done through discussion, but not often measured), music reading skills (knowledge of rhythms and pitches included in music, musical terms, articulations, etc.), an understanding of the structure of the music (key signature, time signature), context, and the technical skill of the individual or ensemble.

MU.Pr1.2.E.MS1 Demonstrate, using music reading skills where appropriate, how knowledge of formal aspects in musical works inform prepared or improvised performances.

MU.Pr1.3.E.MS1 Identify expressive qualities in varied repertoire of music that can be demonstrated through prepared and improvised performances.

Realizing artistic ideas and work through interpretation and presentation

MU.Pr2.1.E.MS1 Use self-reflection and peer feedback to refine individual and ensemble performances of a varied repertoire of music.

MU.Pr3.1.E.MS1 Demonstrate attention to technical accuracy and expressive qualities in prepared and improvised performances of a varied repertoire of music.
