Pomline

Robotics

Pioneer 327, the high school's robotics team, placed second out of 38 teams at the Arizona FIRST Tech Challenge State Championship on February 19. The team won 5 team wards and 1 individual award, more than any other team.

Awards included Inspire Award (overall excellence), 2nd place; Control Award (autonomous robot program), 1st place; Promote Award (compelling video), 2nd place; Innovate Award (bringing great ideas to reality), 3rd Place; Finalist Alliance (1 of 4 teams who qualified for the robot match finals).
