STANDARDS FOR MUSIC ENSEMBLE MIDDLE SCHOOL CHORAL – INTERMEDIATE

CREATING (Imagine – Plan and Make) Conceiving and developing new artistic ideas and work

MU.Cr1.1.E.MS2 Compose and improvise ideas for melodies and rhythmic passages based on characteristic(s) of music or text(s) studied in rehearsal.

MU.Cr2.1.E.MS2 Select and develop draft melodies and rhythmic passages that demonstrate understanding of elements of music (for example: dynamics, tone color, tempo) or text(s) studied in rehearsal.

MU.Cr2.2.E.MS2 Preserve draft compositions and improvisations through audio or video recording and standard notation (using notation in a manner consistent with the genre and with the appropriate skill connected with the level).

CREATING (Evaluate and Refine – Present) Conceiving and developing new artistic ideas and work

MU.Cr3.1.E.MS2 Evaluate and refine draft compositions and improvisations based on knowledge, skill, and collaboratively-developed criteria.

MU.Cr3.2.E.MS2 Share personally-developed melodies and rhythmic passages – individually or as an ensemble - that demonstrate understanding of characteristic(s) of music or text(s) studied in rehearsal.
