

## **Fingerprint Clearance Cards**

Enclosed is the link to the Arizona DPS website, where you can choose to apply for a **"Level One, IVP**" fingerprint clearance card. You will need to have a credit card ready.

## Follow these steps to apply for your Level One, IVP fingerprint clearance card:

- 1) Click on the fingerprint icon on the left side of the screen;
- 2) Click "Fingerprint Clearance Card Applications;"
- 3) Select Apply for a New Clearance Card;

4) You will be prompted to create an DPS account to apply for a card;

5) If you will be a **classified/hourly paid employee** with CFSD, select "Public and/or Charter School" Non-Certified Personnel" as the reason for your application; **OR** 

6) If you will be a **teacher** with CFSD, select the first option, "State Board of Education (Teacher or Other Certification)" as your reason for applying for a card;

7) Select the **digital rolling** option. This is a faster process than paper card/ink rolling.

8) Continue to follow the prompts and enter a credit card number for payment;

9) After your payment is entered, you will receive an **Application Reference Number.** Check your DPS account **'message center**' for additional information about where to go to have your fingerprints rolled;

10) Please forward your IVPP Application Number to CFSD's HR Office (Elsa or Ann Marie), and we will monitor your card progress on-line. Most digital cards are processed and valid within a couple of business days.

## Cards are valid for six years and may be renewed online!

A wallet-sized plastic fingerprint clearance card will be mailed to you at the address in your application.
