STANDARDS FOR MUSIC HIGH SCHOOL INTERMEDIATE & ADVANCED GUITAR ACCOMPLISHED/ADVANCED

Intermediate Guitar and Advanced Guitar are a continuation of Beginning Guitar. An entrance audition is required for Intermediate Guitar if Beginning Guitar was not taken. Students will study more advanced chords, rhythms, note reading, and harmony techniques. Both individual and group studies are included. Emphasis in Advanced Guitar is on advanced note reading and rhythms, and use of upper positions and solo playing. Public performance is a possibility. Placement is by teacher recommendation/audition. Classical acoustic guitars will be provided for class instruction, but it is recommended that students have access to a classical acoustic guitar for home practice.
